Please note that locations marked with the icon are accessible, either by way of a ramp (R) or ground level access (G). The maximum number of stairs (S) are listed for all locations, whether they have otherwise indicated entry points or not. In cases where park visitors might access more than one floor, the numbers are separated by a comma with the first (or ground) floor listed first. The primary surface types (Surface) are also included for each location but transitional surfaces between the locations are not included on this guide. Locations marked with an * are rental spaces that have an accessible restroom inside.
