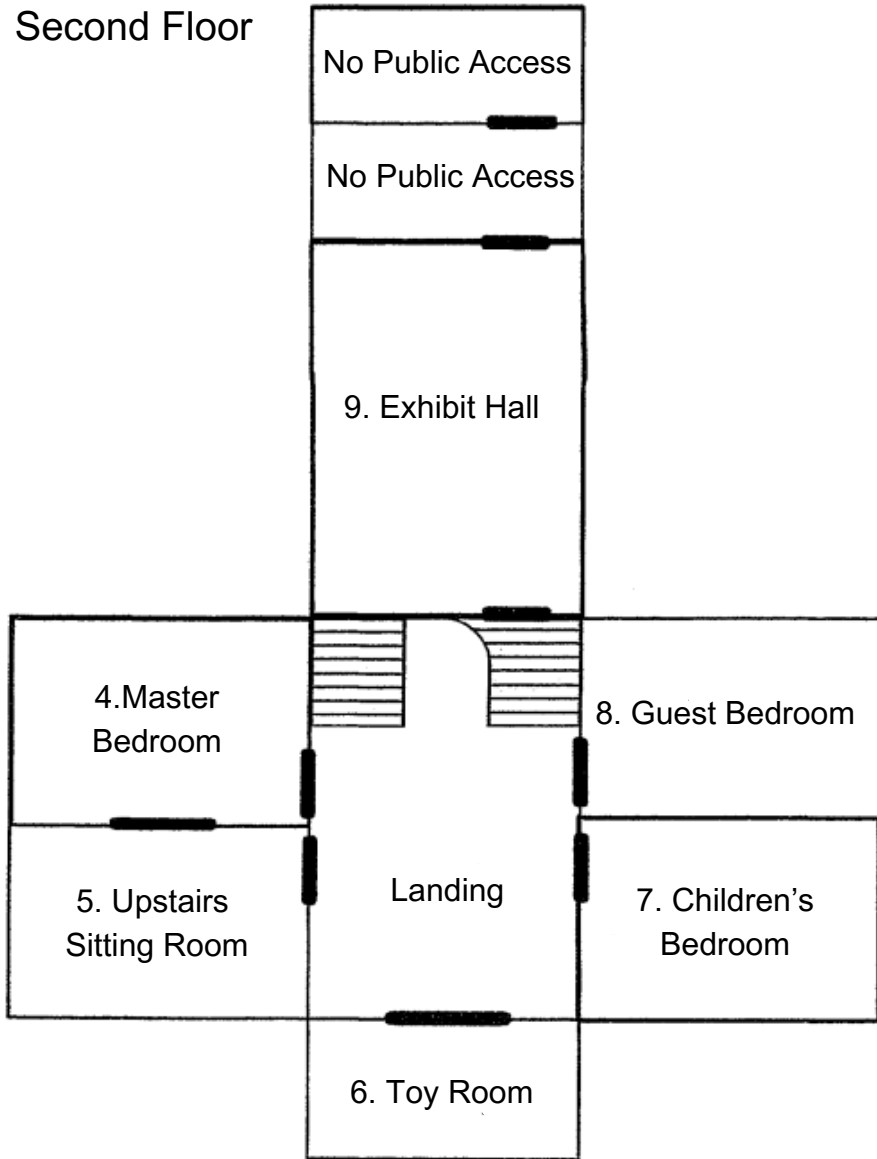
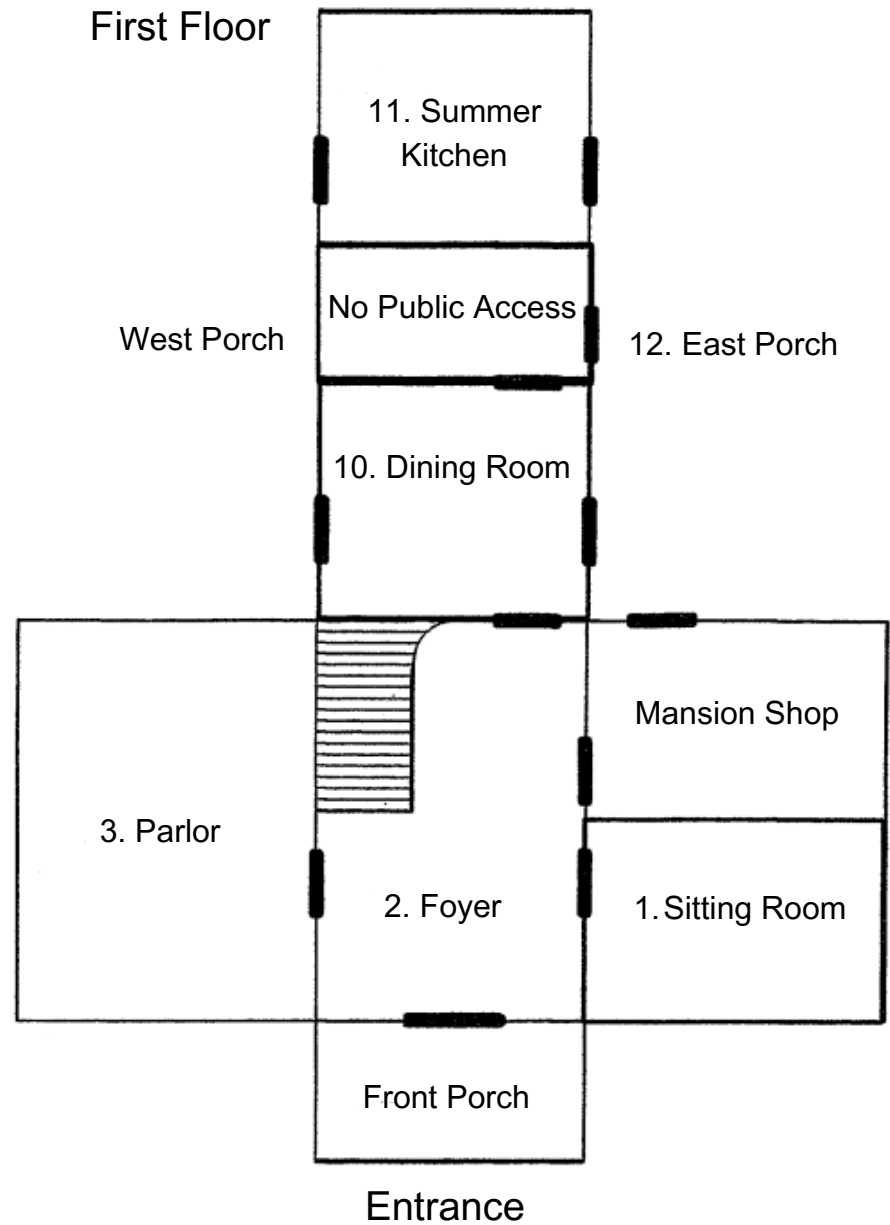


Map of Fort Hunter Mansion

Children's Tour

Please note: The Children's Tour does not visit all rooms of the mansion. Special additions are denoted below. Guests are welcome to visit the Mansion Shop before or after their scheduled tour.

1. Sitting Room - Watch a 7-minute introductory video
 2. Foyer
 3. Parlor - Hear the antique Regina Music Box and touch horsehair furniture
 4. Master Bedroom - Test a handheld fire rattle
 5. Upstairs Sitting Room - Smell fragrance oils common to the Victorian era
 6. Toy Room
 7. Children's Bedroom - Feel samples of straw and horsehair bedding
 8. Guest Bedroom - Not included in Children's Tour
 9. Exhibit Hall - Not included in Children's Tour
 10. Dining Room - Not included in Children's Tour
 11. Summer Kitchen - Hear the servants' bells rung and match artificial foods with the mechanisms associated with them
 12. East Porch - Play cup and ball, game of graces, and others.
